Proposed Bylaw Changes: Current language:

ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS

Section 1. Annual Meeting: the annual meeting of this organization will be held at the May All State Convention of the Kentucky Jaycees. Notice of this meeting will be mailed to each member at their last known address at least thirty (30) days prior to the election meeting. The mailing noted in Article V, Section 3 will be deemed sufficient to meet the needs of both by-laws.

Section 2. Regular Meetings: the regular meetings of this organization will be held on the same weekend as the Kentucky Jaycees hold their All State Meetings. Section 3. Board of Directors Meetings: the President shall designate the location and time of these meetings. Sufficient notice shall be given to all Board Members.

Change (Add this to the end of the section)

Section 4. The KY JCI Senate will try to normally meet with the Kentucky Jaycees but can make other meeting arrangements. Should this be the case the KY JCI Senate Board of Directors will make this determination and announce the change in meeting plans to the KY JCI Senate Membership at least 60 days prior to the normal meeting dates of the 3rd weekend of January, May, and September.
